MATTHEW 18:1-5

At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Who, then, is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?" He called a little child to him, and placed the child among them. And he said: "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

So let me tell you what us adults are doing to try to learn from you. And you can help us!

1.) I am trying to count my blessings

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

You have my permission to remind me to count my blessings!

2.) I'm trying to find joy in small things.

Philippians 4:4

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice.

You have my permission to remind of the joy in small things. Everything doesn't have to be a big deal in order to feel joy. We have so much to be thankful for!

3.) I'm trying to see the miracles of God's goodness that are all around me.

2 Corinthians 9:8-10 NIV

8 And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. **9** As it is written: "They have freely scattered their gifts to the poor; their righteousness endures forever." **10** Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.

Parents: pray over your children, then ask them to pray for you. Let each child lead family in prayer. If they feel emotional, reassure them, they are feeling the presence of God. They could receive the gift of tongues in your home.
