WHEN GOD MAKES A COMMITMENT, HE KEEPS THAT COMMITMENT

Joshua 21:45

Not one of the good promises which the Lord had made to the house of Israel failed; all came to pass.

2 Peter 3:9

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

We have been talking about how God has kept his commitment to the children of Abraham. We have learned about the flag of Israel, about the Star of David, about how Jesus was the Son of David.

I want to remind of some promises of God. And what they mean for you.

1.) GOD IS WITH YOU SO THERE IS NO NEED TO FEAR

"Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand." – Isaiah 41:10

2.) GOD IS IN CONTROL SO I WILL NOT DOUBT

"The LORD of hosts has sworn, saying, 'Surely, as I have thought, so it shall come to pass, And as I have purposed, so it shall stand'" (Isaiah 14:24)

3.) GOD IS GOOD SO I WILL NOT DESPAIR

The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works. Psalm 145:9

4.) GOD HAS ALREADY WON SO I WILL NOT FAIL

"This is how you can recognise the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world. You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world."

1 John 4:2-4

Parents: pray over your child that they would not fear, doubt, despair, or fail.

Now, pray over them, then ask them to pray for you. Let each child lead family in prayer. If they feel emotional, reassure them, they are feeling the presence of God. They could receive the gift of tongues in your home.
